The support of health forms part of the fundamental rights of children. The basis for optimum health has its roots in childhood. In addition to the parents, the school is also committed to strenghtening the health awareness and the health behaviour of children. This includes, among other things, the offers of the School Medical Service. For the purposes of providing equal health opportunities, the School Medical Service supports the optimum health development of all school children from nursery school to secondary school level. The following offers are provided to parents, school children and schools:

Three School Medical Check-ups

For every child, the best possible conditions for a good time at school should be created. For this reason, three statutory school medical

check-ups are prescribed for all school children in

primary school.
They take place
in the 1st year of
nursery school, in
the 5th class and in
the 2nd level of secondary school. In
the 1st year of nursery
school, the check-up
is usually carried

out by the family's paediatrician. It is the aim of the check-up to gain early knowledge of risks to the healh and development of children, in order – if required – to initiate appropriate measures in good time.

Protection against infectious Diseases

Measles, whooping cough, purulent meningitis, etc.: If such diseases occur at a school, we undertake specific measures in order to prevent any further spread.

Vaccination

Vaccination is the best
way to protect yourself and others from
a variety of infectious diseases. We
check the vaccination
protection of
all children
and offer free
vaccinations
on request.

Special Movement Classes

Children who move a lot, sleep better, are able to concentrate better at school and are more mentally balanced. In general, it is important for the healthy development of children that they move around a lot. We offer special movement classes for children with little movement experience and who are overweight.
